Russian has 34 consonants, which can be divided into two types: hard (твёрдый ['tv'ørɔɖij] (help·info)) or plain soft (мягкий ['m'jæx'k'ij]) or palatalized

As stated on the home page, in the Standard Russian dialect and the Central Russian dialect, an /o/ in an unstressed position is pronounced as an /a/. For instance, in the word М о сква [ma'skva] ("Moscow"), the o is in an unstressed position so it is pronounced as an /a/ sound. Unstressed /o/ = /a/ Stressed /o/ = /o/

The common perception is that the pronunciation rules in Russian are rather strict. In reality, they are very complicated and have many exceptions. Pronunciation of Russian letters varies depending on whether they are stressed or unstressed (in case of vowels), and also on which consonants surround the letter.

There are 33 letters in the Russian Alphabet: 10 vowels, 21 consonants, and 2 signs (ь, ъ). Russian is an Eastern Slavonic language closely related to Ukrainian and Belorussian with about 277 million speakers in Russia and 30 other countries. The Cyrillic alphabet was introduced into Russia (Kievan Rus') at the time of its conversion to Christianity (988 AD).

The system of consonants in Russian is characterised by the phonological opposition of palatalised ('soft') and non-palatalised ('hard') consonants that encompasses almost all consonants, with very few exceptions.

So here are a few general rules about pronunciation of Russian consonants: Russian voiced consonants are pronounced as their voiceless counterparts when they appear in the the very end of the word. Example: обѣд - dinner Voiced consonants become voiceless when they are followed by other voiceless consonants.

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
